

Northwest Minnesota Access, Assessment & Homeless Housing Chart

STEPS	DESCRIPTION	SITES/PARTICIPANTS	
Access	<p>Initial point of contact for entry into homeless response system. All access sites must conduct or immediately link (via Housing Screening) to NW Triage/D9iversion Screen. Diversion will either:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Refer to mainstream resources;</li> <li>2. Connect to Prevention Screen; or</li> <li>3. Connect to emergency shelter services; or</li> <li>4. In rare cases, immediately connect to Housing Assessment (VI-SPDAT).</li> <li>5. Document Diversion screen in HMIS or other approved data base.</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>CAPS: BI-CAPP, ICCC, Mahube-Otwa, NWCAA, Tri-Valley – ALL populations</b></li> <li>• White Earth – Tribal only</li> <li>• VOH – Families only</li> <li>• Evergreen - Youth only</li> <li>• VIP: DV only</li> <li>• NWMHC: MI only–24hr</li> <li>• Care &amp; Share – Shelter Access</li> <li>• Red Lake Homeless Shelter-Tribe only</li> <li>• MAC-V: Veterans only</li> <li>• Northwood Coalition: DV only</li> <li>• VA – Vets only</li> </ul>	
Assessment	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Conduct VI-SPDAT (family, youth or single) with household 0-14 days from point of referral or shelter entry.</li> <li>2. Enter VI score and required data into CARES (WC) Priority List.</li> <li>3. Conduct full SPDAT in rare circumstances where VI score is questionable or there is tie in prioritization.</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CAPS: BI-CAPP, ICCC, Mahube-Otwa, NWCAA, Tri-Valley</li> <li>• White Earth</li> <li>• Care Share</li> <li>• Evergreen</li> <li>• NWMHC</li> <li>• VOH- family only</li> <li>• VIP – DV only</li> <li>• Red Lake – tribe only</li> </ul>
