

West Central Minnesota Continuum of Care Homeless To Housed Task Force



Working together to make homelessness, rare, brief and non-recurring

The [HUD CoCBuils NOFO](#) is an opportunity to create new permanent supportive housing (PSH) for persons experiencing homelessness in our region. Funding under this NOFO can go towards new construction, acquisition, or rehabilitation.

This opportunity requires collaboration with community partners and can include subrecipients. Applicants must secure significant leverage to be competitive in this federal competition. A 50% match in any of the following areas if recommended (e.g.) contraction, acquisition, rehabilitation, or service funding).

Amount available: Up to \$7 million is available for the West Central CoC region for up to two projects, one on a Tribal reservation from the Tribe or Tribally Designated Housing Entity and one from non-Tribe or TDHE, or \$5 million for a single non-Tribal project.

Timeline: Online Intent to Apply forms are due by COB on September 27, 2024, and the narrative applications must be submitted [via email](#) to the CoC by October 31, 2024.
